Please review with your child The Chapleau Gymnastics Club Rules. All participants must obey the rules, failure to do so will result in disciplinary measures, up to and including dismissal from the club. You will not receive a refund of your fees should your child be dismissed from the club.

Gymnasts are required to wear proper attire at all times (shorts & T-shirt, track pants, leotard or body suit with gymnastics slippers, flexible running shoes or bare feet). The colour does not matter on regular classes but black (or black and white) will be mandatory for the Gym-a-thon, group photos and the year-end demonstration.

The Board and Coaches also ask that parents bring their children no earlier than 10 minutes before class. This will better enable the coaches to prepare and ensure that the gymnasts are being supervised. Due to some discipline problems, we also request that parents leave the gym class when it begins. To watch your children perform, it would be preferable that you return to do so during the last fifteen minutes of the class.

Please arrive at least 5 minutes prior to the end of the class when picking up your children. Coaches are paid for the class time only and receive no compensation when parents arrive late to pick up their children.

For those parents of the Kinder-gym students, we would request your assistance during set up and dismantling time at the beginning and end of class. Most mats and other items are too large and/or heavy for the students in the Kinder-gym classes to assist in these activities. Please do not hesitate to jump in and lend a hand to the coaches in these activities as it increases available student learning time.
