

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHAPLEAU

BY-LAW NUMBER 73 - 27

A By - law to regulate the use of Motorized
Snow Vehicles within the township of
Chapleau.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Chapleau considers it desirable for public safety to regulate the use of motorized snow vehicles;

AND WHEREAS the Motorized Snow Vehicles Act, c. 283, s.6, R.S.O. 1970 empowers the Council of the Municipality to pass by-laws regulating, governing and prohibiting the driving of motorized snow vehicles along or across any highway or part of a highway under its jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS the council considers it desirable and in the best public interest to prohibit the driving of motorized snow vehicles on certain highways and on all sidewalks within the Township of Chapleau;

AND WHEREAS the council also considers it desirable and in the best of public interest to prohibit the driving of motorized snow vehicles on highways within the Township of Chapleau during certain hours.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Chapleau ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That subject to Section 2 of this By-law, motorized snow vehicles are prohibited from driving on all highways within the Township of Chapleau between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 the next following morning.
2. That motorized snow vehicles are prohibited from driving along the following highways within the Township of Chapleau:
Monk Street from Maple Street to Lisgar Street,
Lisgar Street from Beech Street to Birch Street,
Elm Street from Elgin Street to King Street,
Birch Street from Lisgar Street to Riverside Drive,
Lorne Street from Birch Street to Pine Street,
Pine Street from Aberdeen Street to Lisgar Street,
Young Street from Pine Street to Birch Street,
Beech Street from Lisgar Street to Lorne Street,
Lansdowne Street from Birch Street to Pine Street,
The Railroad grade separation and pedestrian crosswalk
3. That Motorized snow vehicles are prohibited from driving along any sidewalk or public walkway within the Township of Chapleau.
4. That motorized snow vehicles may cross restricted highways describes in Section 2 of this by-law provided said crossing is conducted in the manner prescribed by subsection 1 and 2 of section 5 of regulation 614, R.R.O. 1970.
5. That the towing of skiers by a motorized snow vehicle within the Township of Chapleau is prohibited.
6. That the rules and conditions as laid down in the Motorized Snow Vehicles Act, C.283, R.S.O. 1970 and its amendments and regulations thereto shall pertain to the highways in the Township of Chapleau.

7. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on summary conviction is liable to a fine of not less than \$20.00 and not more than \$100.00.
8. That By-law Numbers 71-25 and 72-19 are hereby repealed.
9. That By-law shall not become effective until approved by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications.
