A nomination must be signed by the candidate and may be filed in person or by an agent on any day in the year that is after January 2nd, 2010 and is before September 10th, 2010 at a time when the Clerk=s office is open or on September 10th, 2010 (Nomination Day) between the hours of 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. A prescribed nomination filing fee (\$200.00 for Head of Council position, \$100.00 for all other positions, paid in cash or by certified cheque or money order payable to the Township of Chapleau) must accompany the nomination form. A nomination must be certified by the Clerk before such person becomes a certified candidate for the office to which she or he is nominated.

If the distance between the residence of a person seeking nomination and the office for submission is greater than 100 kilometers, the person or the person=s agent may file the nomination at the clerk=s office in which the person resides.

In the event there are an insufficient number of certified candidates to fill all positions available, nominations will be reopened for the vacant positions only on Wednesday, September 15th, 2010 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. and such additional nominations, if required, may be filed in the office of the Clerk.

Electors are hereby given notice that if a greater number of candidates are certified than are required to fill the said offices, voting places will be opened on the dates stated below for the purpose of voting.

ADVANCE VOTE(S): Sunday, October 17th, 2010 and Wednesday, October 20th, 2010 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. at the Civic Centre, 20 Pine Street, Chapleau, Ontario.
