

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHAPLEAU

BY-LAW 2010-03

Being a By-law to amend By-law 88-35
a by-law for prohibiting the keeping of animals or any
class thereof within the defined area of the Township of Chapleau.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Chapleau passed
By-Law 88-35 on the 22nd day of August 1988; And

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Chapleau deems it
necessary and expedient to amend By-Law 88-35;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Chapleau
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law 2005-10 be and is hereby repealed in its entirety.
2. That Section 2 be amended by adding the words “golden pheasants and rabbits”
within the parentheses on line three to read as follows:

(excluding dogs, cats, golden pheasants and rabbits)
3. No person shall own, keep or maintain on any lands or premises within the
Township of Chapleau more than two (2) rabbits.
4. That Section 5 be deleted in it’s entirety and replaced with the following:

“Every person who contravenes any provisions of this by-law is guilty of an
offense and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial
Offenses Act.”
5. That all other provisions of By-Law 88-35 shall remain in full force and effect.
6. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on the 18th day of
January 2010.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED this 18th day of
January 2010.
