

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHAPLEAU

BY-LAW NO. 88-35

Being a by-law for prohibiting the keeping of animals or any class thereof within a defined area of the Township of Chapleau.

WHEREAS authority is granted under Section 210 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980 for prohibiting or regulating the keeping of animals or any class thereof within the Township of Chapleau;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Township of Chapleau deems it necessary and expedient to prohibit animals in a defined area of the Township of Chapleau;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Township of Chapleau ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That whenever used in this By-Law the word
 - a) "Council" shall mean the Council of the Township of Chapleau.
 - b) "Person" shall include a Corporation.
 - c) "Place" shall mean any building, erection, dwelling, house stable, hen house, pigeon loft, garage, barn, outhouse, temporary structure or land, or any number of such places owned, operated, maintained, or kept by any one person or corporation on the same plot of land used in conjunction with the other or others of such places.
 - d) "Township" shall mean the Township of Chapleau.
 - e) "Townsite" shall mean all that area as outlined in yellow on the attached plan, forming part of this by-law.
2. No person shall keep any domestic fowl, cattle, goats, swine, horses, rabbits, mink, foxes or other animals (excluding dogs and cats) within the Townsite, as defined by Section 1(e) above.
3. No person shall own, keep or maintain on any lands or premises within the Township of Chapleau more than twenty (20) pigeons and the keeping, maintaining of any pigeons in the Township of CHAPLEAU shall be subject to the following regulations:
 - a) Any such pigeons shall be confined in a pigeon loft which shall be constructed of wire or mesh to prevent the escape of the pigeons therefrom and such pigeon loft shall not be closer than two (2) feet from the boundary line of any adjoining lands.
 - b) All refuse and waste matter from any such pigeon loft shall be disposed of daily in a proper and sanitary manner and no such refuse or waste matter shall be burned.
 - c) Nothing in this by-law shall be deemed to prohibit the keeping of any number of tippler, homing or racing pigeons by any person who is a member of an organized and generally recognized pigeon club; and any such pigeons so kept may be given liberty for not more than one hour in each morning and afternoon, but shall at all other times be kept confined in a properly constructed pigeon loft.

4. That By-law 76-12, be and is hereby repealed in its entirety.
5. Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this by-law shall forfeit and pay, at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate, a penalty not exceeding (exclusive of costs) the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) for each offence.
6. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date it receives the approval of the Ministry of Municipal Affairs.
